BACKGROUND

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INTRODUCTION

Knowledge of fishery biology and management, as well as that of the other fields of the aquatic sciences, lies importantly in published literature. Convenient access to, and use of the literature in any field may very significantly accelerate progress in that field by providing sharpened understanding of principles, and of problems and the methods used elsewhere in solving them. It may also help to create new horizons.

Thailand is very rich in aquatic resources. On these resources rests the fishery industry, reportedly second only to agriculture in importance to the national economy. No wonder then that, in spite of plentiful present aquatic resources, concern is mounting rapidly, commensurate with sharply increasing growth in population, over the future of water—its distribution, quality, quantity, stability, uses and effects of these uses on the fisheries. In the fisheries, the economy traditionally has been one of harvest. Even now there is essentially no management of the fishery resources, excepting fish culture and stocking which are really not extensively practiced and which exist mostly in inland waters on familial or small scale commercial bases. In order to sustain fish production in the face of changing ecological conditions in the hydrosphere, including such unwanted changes as may result from increasing pollution of the water and heavy exploitation of the aquatic organisms, administrators, managers, technicians, investigators, teachers and students need to have increased knowledge of how similar problems have been tackled elsewhere in the world. Thailand has not yet been able to develop a research program strong enough to supply it with answers to many of its aquatic resource questions.

Early in my experience in Thailand it became evident that my professional fishery colleagues were very urgently in need of convenient access to the world literature in the aquatic sciences. I suspected then, as is evidenced now by this publication, that *in or among Thailand's libraries there is no complete set of any serial publication recognized as fundamental to administration, management, research or study of aquatic natural resources*. Concern led me to convene a series of conferences of librarians, aquatic scientists, and other interested persons. In this effort I had the encouragement, advice, and good offices of Dean Chote Suvatti of the Faculty of Fisheries, and the help of Professor C.W. Peters, Chief of Party, Kasetsart/Hawaii University Contract. The Conferees adopted the group name of Committee on Fishery Literature.

The objectives of the work of the Committee were to:

- (1) develop a list of technical serial publications and bibliographic sources of primary value for the advancement of the aquatic sciences and fisheries in Thailand;
- (2) prepare a directory of the holdings of the foregoing publications by important libraries in Bangkok in order to facilitate and encourage use;
- (3) identify the serial literature gaps and develop and implement interinstitutional means for filling these gaps.

METHODS

The list of serial publications and bibliographies and indices of particular value for the aquatic sciences and the fisheries was selected mostly from two sources:

- (1) "Fresh Water Fishery Biology" by Karl F. Lagler, 1956. 421 p., William C. Brown Company, Dubuque, Iowa (Especially, Chapter IV. "Literature", which also outlines a method for developing a bibliography in fisheries);
- (2) World List of Periodicals for Aquatic Sciences and Fisheries, 1962. FAO Fisheries Biology Technical Paper No. 19, Vol. 1, 256 p., Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, Rome, Italy.

Insofar as practical, the names of journals and their abbreviations that we have listed conform to those in the FAO World List.

Abbreviations used to designate libraries in Bangkok known to have holdings pertinent to the aquatic and fishery sciences are as follows:

Siam Society — The Siam Society.

The libraries at the United States Operations Mission (USOM), SEATO Medical Unit, Hydrography Department of the Royal Thai Navy, Office of Atomic Energy for Peace, Chulalongkorn University, and the United States Information Service (USIS) reported no holdings of any of the items listed in this guide.

The data on library holdings are complete through Dec. 31, 1964.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

The following list is composed of three parts. The first part (p. 5) deals with general bibliographies. The second part (p. 9) gives representative bibliographies on special subjects. The third part (p. 11) is a selection of serial publications of significance to the aquatic sciences and fisheries in Thailand and Southeast Asia.

Under "General Bibliographic Sources" (p. 5) are given the most important keys to the aquatic literature. Such broadly inclusive bibliographies as the Zoological Record and Biological Abstracts are included. The outstanding current bibliographic source for the aquatic field is also given here: Current Bibliographic for the Aquatic Sciences and Fisheries (see p. 6). Such general bibliographies are the first sources of information for scholars and students.

Many special bibliographies have appeared in the aquatic and fishery sciences. Often they have been developed by an individual incidental to his professional interest in a fishery organism, a fishery, or an aspect of aquatic ecology. Considerate workers have given the extra effort to such bibliographic works to see them through publication. The user of this list will do well to look among the items incorporated, and among other related ones, to see whether or not a bibliography pertinent to his special concern is or is not already in existence. The attention of the user with interest in Southeast Asia is directed to the several special bibliographies that have appeared among the Occasional Papers of the Indo-Pacific Fisheries Council (FAO, Bangkok) and especially to Occasional Paper 64/3 by A. Soulier, 1964, 15 p. mimeo.: PRELIMINARY LIST OF INFORMATION SOURCES RELATING TO FISHERIES SCIENCES.

The section of this publication entitled "Selected Periodicals" (p. 11) is a directory of serials which ought to be in Bangkok; it is also a guide to the location of what is now present. These serials are listed alphabetically by their proper names or by the name of the country, agency, or society which publishes them. Prevalence in common usage of the journal name has often determined its alphabetical position in the list. Only a few cross references are given. Thus if the name of a journal does not appear in the position where a user first looks for it, he is advised to skim the accompanying widely spaced abbreviations as a supplementary means of finding. Time and shortness of publication funds made it impossible for us to use extensive cross references or to include an index.

As a means of standardizing the abbreviations used for journal names in published bibliographies, scientists, students, and editors are urged to follow the abbreviations given in the list. For the most part these abbreviations conform to those recommended by the FAO and are rapidly gaining adherents who recognize the improved efficiency and clarity inherent in standardization of usage.

SUGGESTIONS TO THAI LIBRARIES

Thai libraries serving interests in the aquatic sciences and fisheries should do several things as soon as possible in order to strengthen their presently very weak positions.

- (1) *Each library should acquire promptly all of the items on the list of GENERAL BIBLIOGRAPHIC SOURCES; in the following list, items of first priority for procurement are prefaced by a superscript numeral 1.*
- (2) *Each library should act at once to fill the broken sets of those serials in the following list for which its holdings are substantial; all libraries should be enabled to exchange all or parts of broken runs of serials and to effect transfers in such a way as to create as complete sets as possible in those libraries already having the strongest holding for any journal (the obvious goal is to get as complete a set as possible into one place for the convenience of all users).*
- (3) *All libraries should rule that there be no removal of parts of serial publications from the library quarters by anyone whatsoever, and furthermore that individual volumes of serials be bound as soon as they are completed in order to protect them against damage and loss.*
- (4) *The present interlibrary Committee should be formalized and charged with the responsibility of developing the means by which the libraries serving aquatic sciences and fisheries may avoid duplication in subscription or purchase of new serials until all serials in the attached list are present in as complete a set as possible in at least one library in Bangkok.*
- (5) *The foregoing Committee might well bring into being better methods than those that now exist for the order, receipt, and payment of book and serial purchases or subscriptions.*
- (6) *All libraries should improve their systems for keeping sets up-to-date, inventoried, and joined with current subscriptions.*

If some persons spent more time than others on this project it was not because all were not willing to share equally in the task. No excuses or apologies are made for omissions or inclusions. This was indeed a labor of love and many arbitrary decisions had to be made in order to achieve this instrument of admittedly limited utility. Hopefully it will be improved, extended, and brought up to date from time to time in the future.
