Article numbering

SEHS has moved from traditional method of sequential page numbering through the volume to article numbering system. This would help us to maintain a rapid, flexible and efficient publication process by being able to define article number as soon as a paper is accepted. Papers in different sections can be published online as soon as they are ready, without having to wait for a whole issue to be allocated page numbers. Bibliographic references will change slightly. Articles should be referenced using a seven-digit article number instead of the page number.
